President's Message: The Fall fishing on Lake Roosevelt has been spectacular on rainbow trout and walleye. The rainbows are in the 15 to 17 inch range now from Kettle Falls to Gifford Ferry. Fishing seems to be better in the morning hours. The sunny fall days have brought out the anglers in between deer hunting adventures. A 00Dodger and single hook and worm trolled at 1.8mph will catch these voracious trout. The walleye have been caught between 45 to 120 feet using Rapalas, dropshot gear, and worm harnesses. The fat walleye are in the 15 to 19 inch range. I have seen lots of regurgitated minnows in live wells all summer and the walleye continue to feast on minnows. Recently noted are walleye spitting out 3.5" suckers. Boaters need to start adding fuel additives and winterized gas treatments to avoid having fuel related issues as winter time boating becomes less frequent.

Gear Swap/Trade: Anyone wanting to bring in usable fishing gear to sell, swap, or give away are encouraged to do so at the November meeting. I have a sack of items that I won't be using but others may wish to try and use.

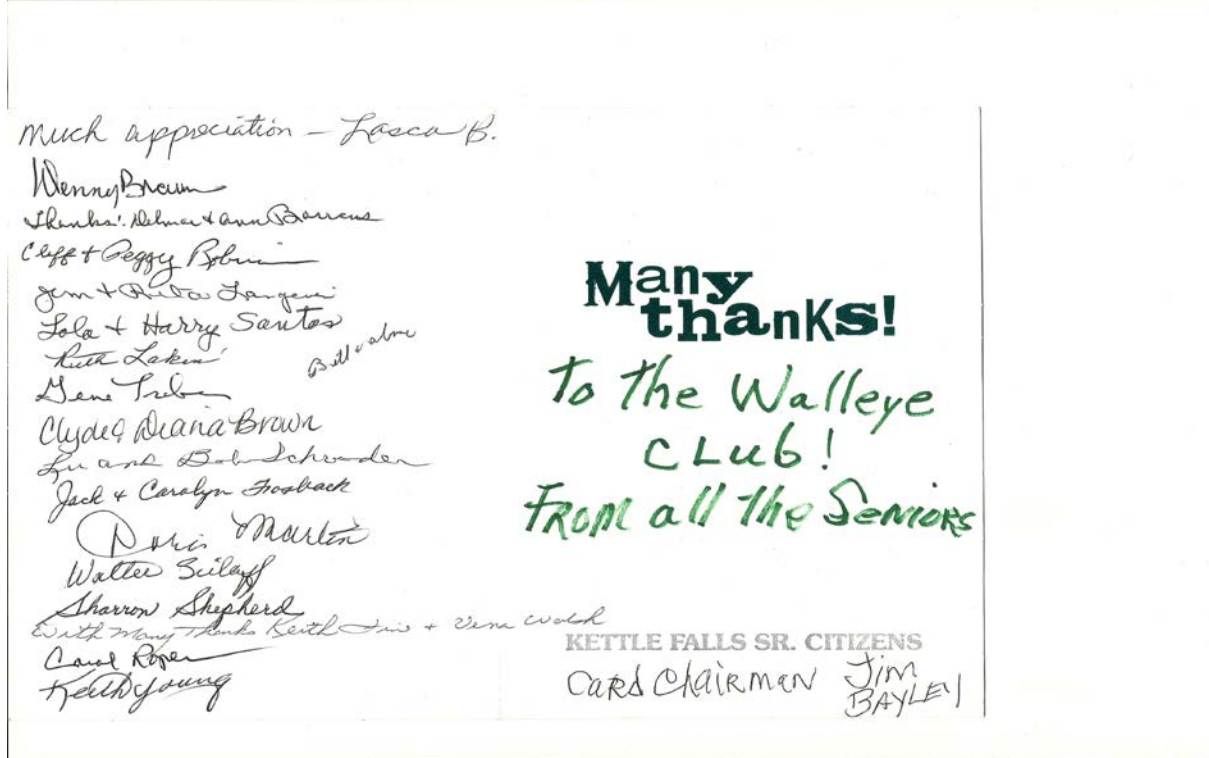
