Some boats caught nothing. Biggest fish I saw was 18 inches, full of belly fat. Live wells are full of small minnows and leeches. So, they are finding food. Also, the net pen rainbows are being caught, average right on 12 inches. The meat is just turning pale red, in another 2 months they will be prime. Soon the Sherman Creek Hatchery will be releasing 20 inch sturgeon from last summers' program. These were the runt fish that didn't make size at the March release. I believe there are about a 1000 of these sturgeon. No word on sockeye fishery at Pateros. Albacore tuna are staged off of Ilwaco right now. We will have to get better details on the large walleye Chad Marcotte caught recently. Doug Unzeitig and Bill Johnson are headed over to Ione to sell Rifle Raffle tickets at the Down River Days this weekend. Doug noted we don't have much time left to sell tickets, drawing will be in mid-September. Thank You to whomever returned the Club coffee pot and tote. See you at the meeting, Jim.

Veggie Pie

1 8 oz. pkg. cream cheese

1 cup mayonnaise

1 pkg. Uncle Dan's Ranch Mix

2 cups grated jack cheese

2 cans crescent rolls

Mix of well chopped vegetables - whatever is colorful - peppers, green onions, broccoli, cauliflower, mushrooms ----

Pat each can of crescent rolls out on two cookie sheets. Bake flat according to directions. Let cool. Mix cream cheese, mayonnaise, and ranch dressing together.

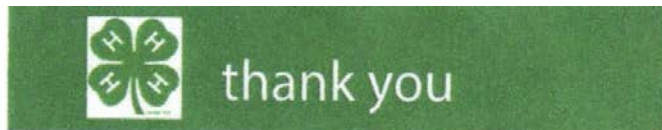
Spread evenly on crescent rolls. Sprinkle chopped vegetables on top. Top with cheese. Cut and serve.

CLUB STUFF AVAILABLE:

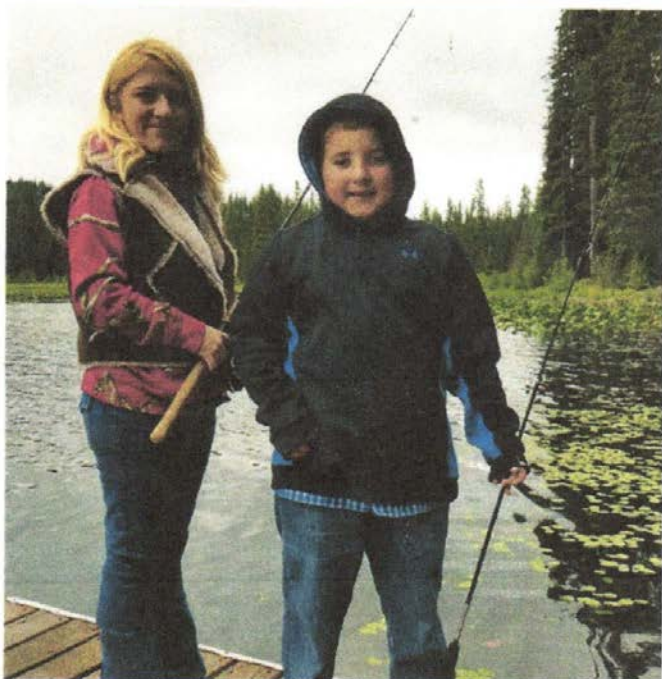
