Presidents Report President's Message: Once again the Governor's Cup Walleye Tournament was a huge success. Many tournament anglers gave compliments on how well organized and how smooth everything worked out. Special Thanks goes to Clyde Renneman, Tournament Director, as well as ALL the Club volunteers to see to it that our tournament weekend was a shining example of how to put on major fishing event. This is the Club's biggest event of the year. Besides our Gun Raffle, the tournament does help raise funds to keep the LRWC in operation. Thanks to Dee Unzeitig for coordinating the very successful Dollar Raffle by purchasing prizes at bargain prices throughout the year. Despite the rain and thunder showers right up to tournament weekend, tournament anglers used every opportunity they had to pre-fish and try to figure out their plan of attack for the weekend. Luckily, the weather held out without rain for the tournament weekend and anglers found quality walleye amongst the 13 inch walleye. Bruce Baker, DFW, and I worked the recovery tank on the dock and very few teams turned in under 16 inch walleye. This years field of 47 boats had 5 Governor's Cup teams. This year's First Place team was Brian Coe/Jeb Race, familiar names regularly in the top ten, with a combined two day weight of 29.05 pounds. Representing the state of Georgia, Ken House and his brother Bill House won the Governor's Cup and took 5th Place with 20.20 pounds. This is the second time Ken and Bill won the Governor's Cup trophy. Local top 10 teams this year were Wayne Dolman/Nick Puryear(2nd) 26.80; Ken House/Bill House(5th) 20.20; and Don Ghramm/Craig Bircher(10th) 19.40. Congratulation Guys!! Total prize money payout was \$22,150. Day 2 final weight separation between 5th and 10th place was 12.8 ounces. The closest final weights within this group were between 6th, 7th and 8th place with less than an ounce difference in weight between them. This was definitely a tournament where ounce(s) were needed to cash bigger checks. One way to grab some extra prize money is to catch Big Fish! Day 1 Big Fish Award went to Brian Coe/Jeb Race(1st) with 7.45 pounder. Day 2 Big Fish Award went to Brad Broadwell/Brian Nielson(8th) with a 5.75 pounder. This year there was a TIE for the Cool Under Pressure Award between Scott Piper/Ted Beach and Brad Broadwell/Brian Nielson as each team advanced 26 places from Day 1 to Day 2. Next year we hope to have several more teams in the field. Thank You goes out to ALL the Tournament Volunteers, Sponsors and Businesses that help support our efforts to host the Governor's Cup Walleye Tournament.

Frantic Search---IF anyone has information or knows the last sighting of the Club coffee pot and sugar, creamer, cups tote please call any of the Club officers.



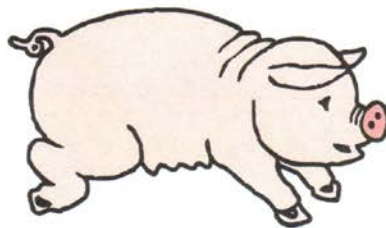
