Recipe of the month: Cheryl Holman - BBQ Pulled Venison

3-4 pound venison roast (I use whatever game we happen to have)

*note: I have also used less tender cuts of meat cut into bite sized chunks

2 cups onion, chopped

1/3 cup brown sugar

1/4 cup vinegar

16 oz. can tomato sauce

2 T Worcestershire sauce

2 tsp chili powder

2 tsp salt

1 tsp dry mustard

In a hot, well-greased, skillet, brown meat on all sides. Place the meat in the crock pot. Add chopped onion. In a small bowl, whisk remaining ingredients until smooth. Pour over roast and cover. Cook about 6-8 hours - this depends on your crock pot (high or low setting) and the meat you are challenged with to cook! I like to start it in the morning and enjoy the wonderful smells all day! If the above mixture doesn't cover the meat or it seems a little dry, I just add chicken, beef, or vegetable broth or a bottle of beer.

If shredded venison is desired, use two forks to pull roast apart into bite sized chunks. Salt and pepper to taste. To enhance flavor, allow to slow cook an additional 15-30 minutes.

Place on rolls or buns of choice and serve warm. Meat prepared this way also makes a great baked potato topper or can be served with buttered noodles or rice. Kept warm in the crock pot it is an easy addition to a potluck.
